




BS Single Euro Profile Cylinder

ERA reserves the right to change specification without notice. It is the responsibility of the door manufacturer to ensure that the finished product meets any required safety and performance specification.

Maintenance

Inspect and review operation of the cylinders and locks at least every 3 months to ensure all items are working correctly, ensure all fixings are secure. Wipe the surface periodically with a soft cloth to remove excess grease or moisture.

Lubrication

Use lubrication/ grease for maintenance. Add lubricate to the key, insert the key into the cylinder key way and rotate for 30 seconds. We recommend this is done at least every 3 months. **IMPORTANT:** Do not use proprietary oils, greases or water displacement sprays. These can clog up the lock and will prevent the lock working over time. Please only use a non-acidic oil such as '3 in 1 oil', avoid using lubricants such as WD40.

Key Handling

Please ensure you use authentic keys that are free from damage to lock and unlock the door. Never force the key into the lock. If the key does not turn easily, check for any obstructions or apply a suitable lubricate/ grease to the key way. Once unlocked, please ensure you use the appropriate handle or cylinder pull when opening the door, **DO NOT** use the key to open the door.

Preventable Measures

Do not leave the key permanently in the lock, as this puts unnecessary strain on the cylinder. Regularly check the cylinder for dirt or debris and clean as required.
